You Bring to class:

-Watercolor Paints –preferably tube paints.

Bring: Indigo (by M. Graham)

Quinacridone Magenta (by M. Graham)

Titanium White

Optional colors – not required:

Viridian

Metallics

-Masking fluid & small brush for application

-Palette – include a place for primary paints and good-sized color mixing spaces. A way to cover the palette for transport to & from class is helpful.

-Watercolor Brushes – Bring:

large round brush (#14 - #16)

Medium round brush (#4 - #8)

Small round brush (#1 or #2)

1/4" – 3/8" flat brush

Optional:

Petals brush (#6)

-Board & Tape (to tape your paper on while painting – blue painters tape works well)

-Paper: A tablet or quantity of 140 lb. or heavier, cold pressed, 9"X12" papers. Brands I like are Canson, Arches or Fabriano, but use your favorite.

-2B or HB Pencil & eraser(s)

-Extra fine sharpie or Micron pen (black)

-Cotton rag or paper towels

Optional – Bring if you have:

-Metallic paint pens

-White paint pen

-Watercolor Wheel or Color Wheel.

Teacher will provide:

Water pitchers & dump buckets

Misc. supplies (as needed) & handouts
