Call for Art

Elm Park Apartments and Elm Park Early Learning Center

Elm Park Apartments and Elm Park Early Learning Center, in partnership with Florence Regional Arts Alliance (FRAA) and BeauxArts Fine Art Materials, is pleased to invite emerging, mid-career, and established artists to submit 2D &/or 3D original artwork for their property.

Elm Park Apartments is an affordable rental housing complex located at 1051 Greenwood Street, and Elm Park Early Learning Center is a co-located four-classroom childcare center at 1001 Greenwood Street. Both are in the City of Florence, north-west of the City of Florence Justice Center. The property is currently under construction, with plans to install the art from this call upon completion of construction and the grand opening of the property. Additional information about this project and its impact on our community is listed at the end of this application under Background Information.

There are several locations for art on these properties, and the call requests two types of art. Each location has specific dimensions and particular requirements.

- 2D works will be purchased and placed in the Elm Park Apartments' Community Room and Rental Office, which will welcome visitors and residents, and in the entry corridor of the Elm Park Early Learning Center, which will welcome children and parents each morning.
- 3D, up to two possible locations for outdoor sculptural work that will be purchased and installed outside. One east of outside the Community Building and the other between Buildings D & E.

Both requests for Art will allow artists to display their work at this location as a permanent cultural fixture for the community. Works submitted will be considered for purchase from the Artist.

The Art selected for these locations will foster community pride, allow artists to share their art in a high-visibility area, and create a sense of place for our community members and visitors.

General Project Information:

- Elm Park Apartments and Elm Park Early Learning Center have selected up to two (2) locations for 3D art.
- Three (3) locations for 2D art have been selected – two for Elm Park Apartments and one for Elm Park Early Learning Center.
- Details of the locations are listed in the Site Plan, and visuals are included in the downloadable Supplemental Materials document, available <https://fraaoregon.org/calendar/call-for-art-2d-3d/>
- There is no fee to enter.
- Artists may submit 3 entries per location.
- Elm Park Apartments and Elm Park Early Learning Center will purchase selected original artwork, which will become their property to display and maintain.
- Art submitted in this call must be available for sale upon selection.
- 3D entries; Elm Park Apartments and Elm Park Early Learning Center will work with the artist to install the art on the base proposed by the artist and accepted by Elm Park Apartments and Elm Park Early Learning Center. Art will be mounted closer to or farther from the ground, depending on its size. Artists should sketch out their desired base and submit it with their application. Elm Park Apartments will consult with the artist and determine the final base. The artist, Elm Park Apartments, and Elm Park Early Learning Center will work out installation details, and the Artist should be present during the installation.
- 2D entries maximum size and space is 48" (height) X 48" (width), excluding frame. It is important that artists adhere to these guidelines, or their work will not be accepted. Can be a single piece, diptych, or triptych.

- 2D art must be clean and odorless. Elm Park Apartments and Elm Park Early Learning Center will supply frame(s). Art must not protrude out from the wall beyond 3”.
- All submitted works must be completed, or, if a mock-up is submitted, a detailed completion timeline must accompany the application.
- Accepted work that differs significantly from work represented in the entry will be disqualified.
- All costs associated with transporting the artwork to Florence, Oregon (to the Elm Park Apartments and the Elm Park Early Learning Center Property), will be the responsibility of the artist.
- All artwork must be the original design of the artist submitting their application. It must also be suitable for all ages/family-friendly.
- All ages, emerging, mid-career, & established artists may apply. For those under 18, this must be indicated in the application and have guardian approval.
- Selected artwork will be scheduled for installation from mid-summer to Winter 2026. The installation schedule will be adjusted based on location and artist, depending on the situation and construction.
- **The deadline for submission is June 1st, 2026, at 11:59 pm PST**
- The Elm Park Apartments and Elm Park Early Learning Center Art Selection Committee determines which work will be purchased. They do not need to make a selection from this call.

- Summer to Winter 2026: New art is installed

Application Requirements

- Complete online application
- When submitting, artists must specify the type of art and the location for which they are submitting their piece (please note that locations have unique requirements).
- Artists may submit up to 3 pieces per location.
- There is no entry fee to submit for this Call for Art.

Artists Must Submit the Following Information for Each Piece of Art:

- Type of Art and Location (2D in the Apartments Community Room and Rental Office, and in the Early Learning Center's entry corridor. 3D for outdoor placement.)
- Title of Work
- Date Created
- Short Description of the Work
- Purchase Price of Art
- Detailed list of materials used
- Height
- Width
- Frame Height, if applicable
- Frame Width, if applicable
- Width of Widest Point or Depth
- Total weight of the piece, if applicable, especially for 3D or heavy 2D
- Artist's history using these materials
- Recommended Maintenance Procedures & Schedule (repairs of possible damage and cleaning)
- Other pertinent information about the work
- Whether art is completed or not. If not, Artists must remit a detailed timeline for completion.

Eligibility Criteria & Design Guidelines:

- All ages, emerging, mid-career, & established artists are encouraged to apply.
 - For those under 18, this must be indicated in the application and have guardian approval.
- There is no required theme; creativity and innovation in design are encouraged, as are themes of community and cooperation.
- Artists must submit photographs of the specific artwork being entered from multiple angles. Work-in-progress, mock-ups, models, drawings, or concepts are accepted for this Call. If work is not fully complete, it must be noted, and a process timeline must be included showing completion by the time of install. Video can be used too, and is especially useful for 3D art.
- Entries must be the original design and artwork of the entrant. Designs must not include any breach of intellectual property, trademarks, brands, business names, corporate or organizational branding, or imagery of violence, drugs, or alcohol.
- Entries must be suitable for viewing by all ages.

- Artwork submitted may not be used for advertisement or to promote a business, product, or viewpoint.
- Artists may submit work individually or as part of a team. Please have one team member serve as the contact person.
- 3D Sculptural Artwork can be in any medium but must withstand coastal weather conditions, including wind and seasonal rain, and be resistant to theft, vandalism, and excessive maintenance and repair costs.
- 3D, Sculptural Artwork cannot exceed 500 pounds in total weight, except with approval by Elm Park Apartments and Elm Park Early Learning Center.
- 3D, Sculptural Artwork Artists must present a plan and diagrams for mounting work.
- Each work will be evaluated to ensure it does not pose a hazard to public safety and that it complies with ADA standards.
