

Make a Watercolor Journal Supply List

with Peggy Ross at Florence Regional Art Alliance, Fall 2026

You Bring:

-Watercolor Paints –preferably tube paints.
Whatever colors you like to use.

-Palette – include a place for primary paints and good-sized color mixing spaces. A way to cover the palette for transport to & from class is helpful.

-Watercolor Brushes – Bring:
large round brush (#14 - #16)
Medium round brush (#4 - #8)
Any other watercolor brushes you like to use

-Board & Tape (to tape your paper on while painting – blue painters tape works well)

-Paper: 140 lb. or heavier, cold pressed, paper for testing on.
Brands I like are Canson, Arches or Fabriano, but use your favorite.

-2B or HB Pencil & eraser(s)

-Extra fine black sharpie or Micron pen

-Cotton rag or paper towels

Optional – Bring if you have:

-Beads, baubles, shells, etc. for Journal embellishment. Must have 2-3 mm hole.

Teacher will provide:

-Paper, binding supplies and tools for making the journal

-Water pitchers, rinse cups & dump buckets

-Misc. supplies (as needed) & handouts
